APPENDIX O. A.

NOTE ON THE AMLI AND VILAYATI ERAS IN ORISSA AND ON THE CALCULATION OF THE
SUNIA" DAY.

1. The Amlī era according to lunar months is the era current in Orissā; but is liable to considerable variation and is regulated by the solar Vilayati year which commences on the 1st Assin.
2. The lunar Amlī year in Orissā commences on the 12th day of the second half of the lunar month Bhādra, the anniversary of the birth of Indradīyāmū, an ancient king of Orissā, which is called the "Sunia" day; and the object of this note is to show how the Lunar Amlī year is kept in correspondence with the solar Vilayati year, and within what limits of the solar year the "Sunia" day can fall.
3. The lunar Amlī year consists of 12 months bearing the same names in the same order as the Vilayati year; but twelve lunar months are $10\frac{3}{8}$ days less than the solar year, and to keep the lunar year in correspondence therewith one month is repeated in every three years. It is a natural phenomenon that once in every three years between the months of Chaitra and Assin, inclusive, in the Vilayati era two new moons fall in one solar month, i. e., on the first and last days thereof; the lunar month which would in the ordinary course bear the same name as this solar month is on this occasion given the same name as the preceding month (repeated) and is called "mala" or inauspicious, the year in which this occurs being also called a "mala" year.
4. Now the lunar months being shorter than the solar months it is clear that any given date in the lunar year must as time goes on after any "mala" month occurs correspond to an earlier date in the solar year; and thus the 12th day of the lunar month of Bhādra (the Sunia day) must be furthest advanced in the solar year when the "mala" month is the nearest possible preceding it; that is when the new moon fall on the first and last day of solar Bhādra, and the lunar month which usually would be called Bhādra is called "mala Srāban," the next lunar month being called Bhādra. A lunar month begins immediately after full moon and the last day of solar Bhādra being the new moon day is thus the last day of the first half of lunar Bhādra; and the 12th day of the second half of lunar Bhādra [the "Sunia day"] is the 12th day of solar Assin. This is the latest possible date.
5. It might at first glance be thought that the date could be still later if Assin were the solar month in which the two new moons fell, and this mala Bhādra was the mala month; but in this case as the mala month is inauspicious the Sunia would fall in the first lunar Bhādra which would then be as far behind solar Bhādra as possible.
6. Next as to the earliest date. It must be a date in solar Bhādra, because the lunar months can only fall less than 33 days at most behind the point at which they are furthest advanced in relation to the solar months, and the lunar months are furthest advanced as already shown when the first day of the second half of lunar Bhādra corresponds to the first day of solar Assin; the 12th day of the second half of lunar Bhādra must therefore fall within the last 21 days of solar Bhādra at the earliest. It is, I think, fairly obvious that the earliest date will be when the 1st day of solar Bhādra is the day before new moon i. e., when the new moon (the last day of the first half of lunar Bhādra) falls on the 2nd day of solar Bhādra, that is when the Sunia (the 12th day after the new moon in lunar Bhādra) falls on the 14th day of solar Bhādra. For if the new moon falls on the 1st day of solar Bhādra mala Srāban takes the place of Bhādra in the lunar year, and it has already been shown that in the case the Sunia occurs on the latest possible date; and if it falls on any later date than the 2nd day of solar Bhādra the Sunia, which falls 12 days after new moon, must be accordingly later. Thus the earliest possible date for the Sunia is the 14th day of solar Bhādra.
7. It is thus ascertained that the Sunia day must fall between the 14th Bhādra and the 12th Assin, inclusive, of solar Amlī years. These dates vary between 27th August and 26th September of the English year.
8. The lunar Amlī era is followed in Orissā for the performance of all religious ceremonies and the Sunia day is strictly observed as the first day of the year from which rents are due, and as the date from which arrears of rent for any year become barred by limitation, and was the year by which instalments of revenue were due according to the proclamation of the Board of Commissioners for Orissā in September 1804; but in Regulation XII of 1805 the Government deliberately adopted the Vilayati year [i. e., the solar Amlī year] commencing on the 1st of Assin as the year by which instalments of revenue should fall due, and this has since remained unrepealed, though practically superseded by the use of English dates for instalments of revenue which has grown up in later correspondence.
9. It only remains to add that in the later Regulations [VI of 1808, I of 1813, III of 1815, VI of 1816, XIII of 1818, and VII of 1822] the word "Vilayati" has been disused and the word "Amlī" has been used to denote the solar era (formerly referred to as Vilayati) by which the lunar Amlī era is regulated and which is referred to as the solar Amlī year in paragraphs 1 to 7 of this note.

APPENDIX P. A.

NOTE ON SALES FOR ARREARS OF REVENUE OF TEMPORARILY SETTLED ESTATES IN CUTTACK.

1. By the proclamation of the Board of Commissioners for Orissa in September 1804, instalments of revenue were due according to months of the lunar Amli year which commences on the 12th day of the second half of the lunar month of Bhadra, a date that varies between the 14th Bhadra and 12th Assin of the solar Amli year. By Regulation XII of 1805, however, this solar year, called "Vilayati," commencing on the 1st Assin, was adopted as the era for instalments of revenue, and in all subsequent regulations the same solar era was followed but was referred to as the Amli era. These remain unrepealed. Under Regulation X of 1818, whenever instalments were not paid up within the month in which they were due according to the settlement list of instalments for each estate, the Collector could issue a certificate called talab chitti or dustuk to the defaulter, and proceed to attach and sell his estates to realize the overdue sums mentioned in the certificate, if the whole was not paid up before the date fixed for sale. It became the invariable practice in Cuttack for all classes of estates to hold only two sales in the year, one on account of 8 annas of the revenue in June and one on account of 16 annas of the Revenue in December, and although most of the Revenue was actually due before June estates were only sold up for default of 8 annas of the demand up to the sale day in June. This it is important, to bear to mind.

2. Regulation XI of 1822 did away with the necessity for issue of dustuk and attachment of estates before sale, and provided for sale after due notification of the arrears for which an estate was to be sold.

3. It will be noted that hitherto no provision had been made in the law for periodical sales on fixed dates in districts or divisions, but nevertheless the old system of periodical sales continued in Cuttack, and in fact no advantage was taken of the provisions of Regulation XI of 1882 and dustuks continued to be issued as formerly.

4. In their Circular No. 55 of the 26th November 1836 the Board directed that for estates paying not over Rs. 10 there should be only one kist, for estates paying not over Rs. 50 only two kists, and for estates paying not over Rs. 100 only three kists. The Commissioner of the Orissa and Midnapur Division made various elaborate proposals for entirely remodelling the kists, but, no definite orders were given to carry them out and in his No. 2506, dated 5/9/39 to the Board he reported that the Collector of Cuttack had only observed the orders conveyed in the Board's Circular quoted above. The kistbandi for Cuttack framed in accordance with that circular had probably existed from before and is given in paragraph 9 below.

5. The Sale Act I of 1845 first defined an arrear (Section 2) as any portion of the kists of one month remaining unpaid on the first day of the next month, and also provided that the Board should determine "upon what dates all arrears of Revenue shall be paid up in default of which the estates shall be sold." Still however no notice was taken in Cuttack of the new law and the old system of a biennial issue of dustuks and sale for 8 annas and 16 annas of the demand went on until 1853 when the Government of Bengal directed the Board to order the discontinuance of dustuks and to fix "the number of yearly sales" (Bengal No. 881, dated 24-10-53). The Board remarked that there was no provision in the law for "fixing periodical dates for sales" but that there was nothing to prevent it and that as the Lieutenant-Governor stated he would recommend the Government of India to modify the law so as to provide for this in future, the Board proceeded to fix dates subject to the proviso, that until the new law came into force the arrear lists in each case must come up to the Board for formal sanction.

6. After much discussion these dates were fixed as the latest days for payment of 8 annas and 16 annas of the Revenue demand and the dustuk system was abolished with effect from the 1st January 1854.

7. The dates fixed were the 28th April and 8th November. Those first proposed were 1st May and 1st November and the object was (as clearly appears from Commissioner's No.—of 11-11-53 to the Board, though this has been lost sight of in more recent correspondence) not to disturb the existing arrangement by which sales were held in June and December; the date 1st May was put back to 28th April in order to realize as much as possible of the Revenue within the official year which then closed on the 30th April; the cause of the slight modification of 1st to 8th November I have not been able to discover.

8. The verification of the foregoing history will be found in the following correspondence:—

9. Meanwhile the general settlement of Orissa had taken place, and though no list of instalments was as a rule entered in the kabuliyats, it seems to have been generally accepted that an old kistbandi existed; this was as follows, (it will be remembered that the local year begins in September) for estates paying Revenue:—

10. Now whatever may have been the old instalments in former Settlement agreements it is beyond all doubt clear, that (except in the case of estates paying revenue under Rs. 10 the whole revenue of which was due at one time) estates had always been liable to sale for any unpaid portion of only 8 annas in June and of 16 annas in December. Estates paying revenue under 10/- have never in fact been sold except at the latter sales, and years later in Board's Cir. No. 7 of 1885, paragraph 2, this practice was formally recognized, see also paragraph 19 of this Note.

11. As regards estates in Class II and Class IV 10 annas 8 pies and 14 [or 13 annas according as the instalment list was by vernacular or English months] was due in months previous to that in which the 28th April falls and estates might have been declared by the Board liable to sale for the whole amount of such arrears on that date; this was fully recognized (*vide* Mr. Ricketts' Memo. sent with Commissioner's No. 55, d. 22/11/53 to the Collector of Cuttack) and the orders deliberately determined that the sale should be for arrears of only 8 annas of the demand nevertheless.

12. As regards Class III, the month of Chaitra ends about the middle of April, so that if the settlement list of instalments was by vernacular months 12 annas of the demand were always arrears if unpaid before the 28th April, but if it went by the English months 4 annas only would be arrears and the Board's orders fixing a sale for 8 annas would have been illegal. The Settlement era is and always has been the solar Amli era, and whenever it was that the English names of months were first used the fact that the clerical change to English months might render illegal, the ancient established custom of the country in this instance was never brought to light, and the legality of the orders was never questioned. A careful search has been made through all last settlement kabuliyats and in only 3 estates has any kistbundi been found. These are all big estates, and the kistbundi sets forth in each case that the settlement is made for a period of the Amli era, but the months in which each kist is due are named by the names of English months as given for Class IV, of estates in para. 9 of this note. In all other kabuliyats only the total revenue and the period (or the Amli era) for which settlement is made is stated. It appears, thus, that the old kistbundi was deliberately omitted from the last Settlement kabuliyats. It is from old Appendix B at page 163 Ch. VI. of Board's Rules of 1878, since cancelled, that I gather that kistbundis by English and by native months existed side by side, but the same shows clearly that both were by the Amli era.

13. To resume the thread of the argument up to the end of para. 7. The Board's orders fixing the latest day of payment for 8 annas of the demand for all estates as the 28th April and for 16 annas on the 5th November were given effect to from the 1st January 1851. In 1859 came the new sale law which left sections 2 and 3 of Act I, 1845, unaltered as to the definition of an arrear and the direction to the Board as to determining latest days.

14. Now this section 3, both in Act I of 1845 and Act XI of 1859, can obviously bear either of two distinct meanings:—

- (a) That the Board is to fix the latest days of payment for all arrears of revenue, and that every estate shall be sold if all those arrears are not paid up by those days.
- (b) That the Board are to fix the latest days of payments, and the amount of arrears for which estates are to be sold, if all such arrears are not paid up by those latest days.

I am not aware if any legal opinion has been given on this point. Except in Orissa the Board only did fix latest dates, but in Orissa it fixed both the dates and the amount of arrears for which the estate could be sold on each date, and fixed them, as already said, with the full knowledge that these were not the full sum of arrears outstanding before those latest days, and there can I think be no doubt that the Board then read the second meaning into section 3 of these Acts. In any case estates continued to be sold after 28th April only if 8 annas was not paid in full by that date, and only for that 8 annas of the demand and not for all the sums that were arrears under section 2 of the Acts on the 28th April according to the old kistbundi, and the determination under section 3 of the Acts that estates were only liable to sale for 8 annas on the 28th April and 16 annas on the 8th November continued to be entered in the table of latest day in the Board's rules in the editions published from time to time until after 1892.

15. I now come to the explanation of how the Board's rules came to be altered to what they now are in the 1896 edition, page 210; and to make my object clear I will first explain how that rule stands.

16. In the table of latest dates the old dates and amounts due have been cancelled, and instead the words "*vide* the next rule" have been put in. The next rule purports to show the instalments in which the revenue of Orissa is paid, but what it actually does show for temporarily settled estates is:—

- (a) For the classes of estates paying revenue not over Rs. 100 the total amounts which would be arrears under section 2, Act XI of 1859, on each latest day of payment if the settlement list of instalments were by English months.
- (b) For estates paying revenue over Rs. 100 only so much of those arrears as were determined by the Board under section 3, Act I of 1845, to be arrears for which estates are liable to sale.

This rule has in practice been taken to mean that estates are now to be sold not for the proportions of arrears for which they have been sold from time immemorial, but for the proportions shown in col. 2 of the table in the said rule 2, p. 211 of the 1896 edition of the Board's rules. The change was effected merely on a reference regarding the routine of the Tauzi Department and the propriety of such a change has never been discussed with this office.

17. To resume the history of how this change was effected, I think if the sequence of orders be traced it will be very clear.

18. In 1873 the Board issued a memorandum of Revenue Administration in which a special account of Orissa was given, and in sections 80 and 81, pp. 55 to 59 (in connection with financial questions which I avoid as they add terrible confusion to the terms regarding years, instalments, and arrears) a brief summary of the history I have given in paras. 1 to 8 will be found. In section 81 of this memo. it is again distinctly repeated that only 8 annas of the demand is realizable by sale, although more than 8 annas is due according to the Settlement list of instalments in months previous to the sale month. The Settlement list of instalments are then quoted in English [section 81 will show that difficulties had already arisen owing to their quoting the months in English instead of the vernacular, the whole matter is arranged by English months of the financial year and a confusion of ideas was started thereby, which will die a very hard death.]

19. The next step was in 1885 when the Board in their circular No. 7 of April 1885, para. 2, made a simple correction in the list of latest days for Orissa mentioned in paras. 6 and 7 above, viz., to recognize that estates paying revenue under Rs. 10 were only sold at the 2nd latest day for any arrears of the whole demand (cf. para. 10 above). As a matter of interest the Board in para. 3 of the same circular also added to their rules a para. (extracted probably from para. 81 of the memo. of 1873 quoted above) stating that the Revenue of Orissa is paid in the following instalments :—

20. Now in the first place it is quite obvious that this was never meant to supplant the Board's table of latest days of payment determined under section 3, Act I of 1859, because that table is modified by para. 2 of the circular which would have been quite superfluous if such was the intention of para. 3, and because any such alteration would have needed a formal gazetted order under section 3 of the Act, and because from the wording of the circular it is clear that it merely means to state a fact.

21. The fact, however, that revenue was so paid was incorrectly stated. In the first place revenue had then for some time been only paid on account of the amounts for which an estate could be sold at each latest day, and no accounts of instalments according to the settlement kistbandi were kept in the Tauzi Department, but all sums were credited to the "8 anna kist" of the "16 anna kist". Again, as already pointed out in para. 12 in the case of estates paying revenue over Rs. 50, but not over Rs. 100, the amount shown against the latest day 28th April is only four annas of the demand, and this is the amount which would be an arrear under the definition in section 2, Act XI of 1859, before the 2th April (i.e., on the 1st April) if the settlement list of instalments were by English months. As a matter of fact the Settlement year is and always has been the solar Amli year, commencing on the 1st Assin about the middle of September, and this makes a serious difference, for in estates paying between Rs. 50 and 100 the instalment due in Chaitra, which is an arrear on the 1st Magha (about the middle of April) is therefore an arrear before the 28th April, and had in the old days always been considered as due before that date, though only 8 annas thereof was treated as realizable by sale. Had this not been so the Board's orders as to the amount of arrears realizable on each latest day would have been illegal and the immemorial practice incomprehensible.

22. In estates over Rs. 100, the fact stated no doubt is true, that "the revenue of estates in Orissa is paid in two instalments of 8 annas and 8 annas," but this is nothing to do with the settlement list of instalments by which (see para. 11 above) 14 annas (if revenue is due by vernacular months, and 13 annas if it is due by the English months) is an arrear before the 2th April.

23. The object of this circular No. 7 of 1885 seems to have been due to a desire to make clear, that as a matter of fact revenue was due in Orissa in instalments which differed widely from the proportion in which arrears could be realized by sale; the mistake in the 2nd class of estates Rs. 50 to 100 was due to the papers before the Board being in English and the mistake in the case of estates over Rs. 100 must I think have been due to a confusion of ideas arising out of a half recognition of the fact that the settlement list of instalments was a dead-letter. But why this was not equally recognised for all classes of estates I cannot conjecture. However the main point is that it purported merely to state an interesting fact, and not to be a formal alteration of the Board's orders under section 3 of the Sale Act.

23. The practice in the Tauzi Department in Orissa, however, which has been formerly recognized in the Tauzi Manual is as stated in para. 21 that the demand for each kist in the Tauzi accounts is the amount of arrears for which an estate can be sold, and no payments have

ever been credited otherwise than on account of such proportion of arrears. The Tauzi Department, therefore, took this circular to direct that, in future payments were to be made in a different manner and thereupon the Collector of Cuttack's letter No. 960, dated the 26th August 1885, to the Commissioner (drafted by a clerk and passed without comment) was issued saying that the change effected by this circular meant an enormous amount of re-writing tauzi accounts and asking permission to postpone the introduction of the "alterations in the proportions of kists of revenue in the estates in Orissa" till next year. Permission to do so was given by the Officiating Secretary to the Board in his No. 248-A., dated the 28th September, and this was accepted in the Tauzi Department of this district as an authority to alter the immemorial custom of sale for 8 annas in April and for 16 annas in November, and to sell for the amount of arrears noted in col. 2 of the table in para. 3 of Board's circular No. 7 of April 1885.

24. No further report however was sent up, and in 1888 a new volume of Board's rules was issued in which the table of latest days remained the same as in former days with the simple modification made by para. 2 of Cir. 7 of 1885, and the additional para. added by para. 3 of the same circular remained as merely an appendix.

25. In 1891 the Government took up the question of altering the latest days of payment for Bengal and in Bengal Governments No. 891 L. R., dated 11th July 1891, the old orders for sale on account of 8 annas and 16 annas on 28th April and 8th November were quoted as still in force. This para. was marked in this office as evidently a subject for consideration, but I can find no letter in which the statement was challenged. The Commissioner, however, had much correspondence with the Settlement Department, and I presume that in consequence of a report as to the now existing practice which had been put in force since 1886 it was reported that estates were sold for the arrears mentioned in para. 3 of Cir. No. 7 of April 1885 and in December 1892 the Board sent a correction slip to cut out from the table of latest days of payment all the entries for Orissa and substitute the words "*vide the next rule*"

26. The effect of this has been to retain the ancient practice for estates paying revenue over Rs. 100, in spite of the fact that a much larger sum is arrears under section 2, Act I of 1859, before the 28th April, and to sell up estate paying revenue not over Rs. 100 for the sums which would be arrears before April 28th under section 2 of the Act, if the last Settlement kistbandi were by the English months shown in the table instead of the vernacular months shown in para. 9 of this Note against each, and the general effect of this has been to sell estates paying revenue between Rs. 10 and 50 for default of a larger proportion than in the past, and of estates paying revenue from Rs. 50 to 100 for default of less sums than in the past.

27. Matters have however been still further complicated by Board's circular No. 12 of February 1896, which was considered to direct that all partitioned estates should be classed not according to the revenue which they pay, but according to the revenue which the last Settlement Mahal from which it has been partitioned originally paid, and this has necessitated a further general revision of Tauzi accounts.

28. In conclusion then it seems to me to be desirable—

- (a) That Board's circular No. 16 of December 1892 should be cancelled and the original table of latest days of payment for Orissa should stand as modified only by para. 2, circular No. 7 of April 1885.
- (b) That para. 3, circular No. 7 of April 1885, be cancelled.
- (c) That in view of the re-settlement of Orissa and the probability of a fresh order under section 3, Act XI of 1859, it be authoritatively declared that section is intended to give the Board the power not only to fix the latest days for payment of arrears as defined under section 2, but to limit the proportion of such arrears for which if not paid in full before the said latest day the estate is liable to sale; or that a revised kistbandi be made so that exactly 8 annas of the demand becomes an arrear before 28th April in all estates paying over Rs. 10.
